## Yarn requirements:

100g Wendy Merino DK Funghi  
50g Wendy Merino DK Putty  
50g Wendy Merino DK Smoke  
Scrap amounts of Jet (black)

## Necessary tools:

3.5mm straight needles  
Crochet hook (to create the eyes)  
Tapestry needle  
Toy stuffing  
3 small buttons

## Instructions:

### Body:

Using Funghi, cast on 8 sts.  
Row 1: [Kfb] 8 times. 16 sts  
row 2 and all even rows: P.  
Row 3: [K1, kfb] 8 times. 24 sts  
Row 5: [K1, kfb, k1] 8 times. 32 sts  
Row 7: [K2, kfb, k1] 8 times. 40 sts  
Row 8-24: st st 17 rows.  
Row 25: [K2, k2tog, k1] 8 times. 32 sts  
Row 27: [k1, k2tog, k1] 8 times. 24 sts  
Row 29: [k1, k2tog] 8 times. 16 sts  
Row 31: [K2tog] 8 times. 8 sts  
Break yarn and thread through rem. sts. Pull tight and fasten. Using mattress st sew along the side edge and stuff.

## Arms: (make two)

Using Funghi, cast on 8 sts.

Row 1: K.

Row 2: Cast on 2 sts, p to end. 10 sts

Row 3: Cast on 2 sts, k to end. 12 sts

Row 4-22: St st 19 rows.

Row 23: [K2tog] 6 times. 6 sts

Break yarn and thread through rem. sts. Pull tight and fasten. Using mattress st sew along the side edge up to row 4. Attach to either side of the body.

## Legs: (make two)

Starting from the bottom of the foot cast on 10 sts using Funghi.

Row 1: K1, [kfb] 8 times, k1. 18 sts

Row 2 and all even rows: P.

Row 3: K1, [k1, kfb] 8 times, k1. 26 sts

Row 4-6: St st 3 rows.

Row 7: K4, [k2tog, k1] 6 times, k4. 20 sts

Row 9: K4, [k2tog] 6 times, k4. 14sts

Row 10-24: St st 15rows.

Cast off. Fold the piece in half sideways and sew along the cast on edge using mattress st and stuff. Next sew along the side edge and finish stuffing. Attach to the bottom of the body

## Head:

Starting from the front, cast on 16 sts using Funghi.

Row 1-2: St st 2 rows.

Row 3: [K1, kfb] 8 times. 24 sts

Row 4-6: St st 3 rows.

Row 7: {K1, kfb, k1} 8 times. 32 sts

Row 8-10: St st 3 rows.

Row 11: [K2, kfb,k1] 8 times. 40 sts

Row 12 and all even rows: P.

Row 13: [K2, kfb, k2] 8 times. 48 sts

Row 15: [K3, kfb, k2] 8 times. 56 sts

Row 16-26: St st 11 rows.

Row 27: [K3, k2tog, k2] 8 times. 48 sts

Row 29: [K2, k2tog, k2] 8 times. 40 sts

Row 31: [K2, k2tog, k1] 8 times. 32 sts

Row 33: [K1, k2tog, k1] 8 times. 24 sts

Row 35: [K1, k2tog] 8 times. 16 sts

Row 37: [K2tog] 8 times. 8 sts

Break yarn and thread through rem. sts. Pull

tight and fasten. Using mattress sts sew along the side seam and stuff. Gather the stitch of the cast on edge and close. Position the sewn part of the side seam to the top of the boy and secure. For the eyes, use some scrap amounts of black crochet a chain of 6 sts and join in the round. Attach to either side of the face. Sew a V shape to the snout for the nose.

## Ears: (make two)

Using Funghi, cast on 14 sts.

Row 1-2: St st 2 rows, starting with a k row.

Row 3: [Kfb, k5, kfb] twice. 18 sts

Row 4-8: St st 5 rows.

Row 9: [Kfb, k7, kfb] twice. 22 sts

Row 10-14: St st 5 rows.

Row 15: [Kfb, k9, kfb] twice. 26 sts

Row 16-20: St st 5 rows.

Row 21: [Kfb, k11, kfb] twice. 30 sts

Row 22-26: St st 5 rows.

Row 27: [K2tog, k11, k2tog] twice. 26 sts

Row 28 and all even rows: P.

Row 29: [K2tog, k9, k2tog] twice. 22 sts

Row 31: [K2tog, k7, k2tog] twice. 18 sts

Row 33: [K2tog, k5, k2tog] twice. 14 sts

Row 35: [K2tog, k3, k2tog] twice. 10 sts

Break yarn and thread through rem. sts.

Pull tight and fasten. Using mattress sts sew along the side edge and attach to either side of the body.

## Hat: (Do not cut the yarn when changing colours)

Using Smoke cast on 56 sts.

Row 1: K1, \*k2, p2; rep from \* to last 3 sts, k3.

Row 2: P1, \*p2, k2; rep from \* to last 3 sts, p3.

Row 3-6: Repeat rows 1-2.

Row 7: Change to Putty and k15, cast off 4 sts, k18, cast off 4 sts, k15. 48 sts

Row 8: P15, cast on 4 sts, p18, cast on 4 sts, p to end. 56 sts

Row 9-12: Change to Smoke and st st 4

rows. From here on alternate Putty and Smoke every 2 rows, working every even row as a purl row.

Row 13: [K3, k2tog, k2] 8 times. 48 sts

Row 15: [K2, k2tog, k2] 8 times. 40 sts

Row 17: [K2, k2tog, k1] 8 times. 32 sts

Row 19: [K1, k2tog, k1] 8 times. 24 sts

Row 21: [K1, k2tog] 8 times. 16 sts

Row 23: [K2tog] 8 times. 8 sts

Row 24: P.

Break yarn and thread through rem. sts.

Pull tight and fasten. Using mattress sts sew along the side edge.

### Cardigan:

Using Putty, cast on 46 sts.

Row 1: K2, \*p2, k2; rep from \* to end.

Row 2: P2, \*k2, p2; rep from \* end.

Row 3-6: Repeat rows 1-2.

Row 7: K.

Row 8 and all even rows: K5, p to last 5 sts, k5.

Row 9: K5, [k2, k2tog, k2] 6 times, k5. 40 sts

Row 10: K5, p to last 5 sts, k5.

Row 11: K.

Row 12-18: Repeat rows 10-11.

Row 19: K12, cast off 4 sts, k8, cast off 4 sts, k12.

Working on the first 12 sts only:

Row 20: K5, p to end.

Row 21: K.

Row 22-25: Repeat rows 20-21.

Row 26: K5, p2tog, p1, [p2tog] twice. 9 sts

Cast off and join yarn to the middle 8 sts.

Row 20-24: St st 5 rows starting with a p row.

Row 25: K3, cast off 2 sts, k3.

Row 26: P3, leaving the other 3 sts waiting.

Cast off these 3 sts. Join yarn to the other 3 sts waiting and purl 1 row, then cast off.

Join yarn to the 12 rem. Sts

Row 20: P7, k5.

Row 21: K.

Row 22-23: Repeat rows 20-21.

Row 24: P5, k1, k2tog, yo, k2.

Row 25: K

Row 26: [P2tog] twice, p1, p2tog, k5.

Cast off.

### Sleeves: (make two)

Using Putty, cast on 12 sts.

Row 1: Kfb, k to the last st, kfb. 14 sts

Row 2: Pfb, p to the last st, pfb. 16 sts

Row 3-4: Repeat rows 1-2. 20 sts

Row 5-16: St st 12 rows.

Row 17: K1, \*k2, p2; rep from \* to last 3 sts, k3.

Row 18: P1, \*p2, k2; rep from \* to last 3 sts, p3.

Row 19-20: Repeat rows 17-18.

Cast off.

Using mattress st sew along the side edge.

Sew the middle 3 cast off sts to st st side of the shoulders on either side. Secure the sleeves to the arm holes. Attach a small button to the top of the coat.

### Dungarees:

Using Smoke, cast on 22 sts.

Row 1-12: St st 12 rows starting with a k row.

Break yarn and create a second trouser leg.

Row 13: K22, join and k across the other 22 sts. 44 sts

Row 14-30: St st 17 rows.

Row 31: Cast off 14 sts, k to end. 30 sts

Row 32: Cast off 14 sts, k3, p10, k3. 16 sts

Row 33: K.

Row 34: K3, p10, k3.

Row 35-42: Repeat rows 33-34.

Row 43-46: G st 4 rows.

Cast off.

Starting from the cast on edge, sew along the side edge using mattress stitch of each leg separately, then continue along the side edge all the way to the top.

### **Straps: (make 2)**

Using Smoke, cast on 16 sts.

Row 1: P.

Row 2: K2tog, yo, k to end.

Row 3: P.

Cast off.

Attach the side edge to either side of the back of the dungarees.. Attach two small buttons to the front and button up.
